TIANNENG POWER STARTS MASS PRODUCTION AND SALE OF ELECTRIC CAR MOTIVE BATTERY

BOASTS INDUSTRY-LEADING R&D AND PRODUCTION CAPABILITIES

(Hong Kong, 9 February 2010) – **Tianneng Power International Limited** (“Tianneng Power” or the “Company”) (stock code: 00819.HK), a leading new energy solutions provider in China, has kicked off commercial production and sale of electric car motive batteries with an estimated annual output enough to cater more than 1,000 electric cars in 2009 for use mainly during the Shanghai World Expo and by commercial and urban public vehicles.

The motive batteries produced by Tianneng Power employ mainly lead-acid and super-capacitor technologies. The Company has also been developing new technologies for producing lithium battery and nickel hydride battery. Currently, the Company has 12 specification models of electric car motive battery in its portfolio, including seven models of 12V series, three models of 6V series, and 2 models of 8V motive battery. Among the 12, four models have passed quality tests conducted by the authoritative China Northern Vehicle Research Institute (中國北方車輛研究檢測中心).

In addition, Tianneng Power has passed the mandatory TS16949 quality standard system accreditation under the new requirements for the electric car motive battery industry. It has also filed two invention patents and 10 utility model patents related to electric car motive batteries.

Mr. ZHANG Tianren, Chairman of Tianneng Power, said, “As a leading new energy motive battery enterprise in China, apart from reporting the highest sales of electric bike motive batteries in China for 11 consecutive years, Tianneng Power has also managed fast development of electric car motive batteries leaving its peers trailing behind in production and sale of the batteries. Tianneng Power also has the most products passing local authoritative product inspections among industry players. This achievement is attributable to the dedication and efforts of our R&D arm and our determination in developing new energy batteries.”

“We are also pleased to enjoy industry recognition. The recent accolades we received included the ‘Most Trusted Electric Car Battery Brand of Consumers’ and ‘Outstanding Contribution to the Development of the Electric Car Industry’ from CCTV.com and the ‘Chinese Best Brand of Motive Battery’ for electric bikes from Frost & Sullivan. In the days to come, we will continue to focus on R&D, so as to develop innovative and quality new products and consolidate our leading industry presence.” Mr. Zhang concluded.

About Tianneng Power International Limited

Tianneng Power is the largest electric bike motive battery supplier in China. The Company's motive battery products are sold under its brand name "TIANNENG". In 2008 and 2009, the Company was awarded "Chinese Best Brand of Motive Battery" in the electric bike battery market by Frost & Sullivan. To cope with the national policy of energy saving, the Company launched a renewable energy project in Shuyang Country of Jiangsu Province in March 2008, to produce storage battery relating to solar and wind energy for power plant and public lighting system, etc. The project has commenced production in June 2009 and is expected to start mass production in 2012. In order to speed up the development of motive battery products for pure electric cars, the Company entered into various cooperation arrangements with certain car manufacturers. The Company also undertook the investment in the renewable energy and battery recycling business in Changxing Economic Development Zone of Zhejiang Province. The investment is expected to produce 6,000,000 KVAH motive batteries and recycle 150,000 metric tons of used lead-acid batteries by 2014 and 2012 respectively.
